Grand Lecturer, Sister Viola Hayter: In all chapters I have found the true fraternal spirit existing. You know the real essence of the fraternal spirit is to be ever mindful of the welfare of others, to bring cheer and gladness into other lives. It has been said that “coming together” is beginning, “working together” is progress, “keeping together” is success.

Of the inspections I have made, 83 have been individual and 28 grouped. We realize it is much easier on the Inspecting Officer to inspect 28 chapters in 14 nights than to take 28 nights for the work. I also made 17 social visits.
