The lovely garden scene in front of the stage included a bird bath, complete with Angel, a small pool surrounded by turtles, white wrought iron benches and a large owl on a pedestal. The front of the stage was covered with wallpaper of white brick and ivy. Tucked into the base were all the silk flowers and ribbons from the corsages the Worthy Grand Matron had received during her year. Behind each chair in the Labyrinth, a beautiful Angel, dressed in appropriate colors, stood on a lighted star-shaped box. An impressive Effulgent Sun graced the Grand Chapter West.
