DD Schools Cancelled

With the rise of COVID numbers and the age and health of most of our members, I am canceling the DD schools that were to be held in the spring. We were hoping that the numbers would be better, but they are going in the wrong direction. Most schools were going to have between 3-5 chapters involved in each school. With the small chapter rooms, sharing of conductress staffs, gavels, proving the chapter (which was going to start again with the schools) with taking the pass and the grip of the order, we don't feel it's the time to do that yet. Our Grand Lecturer, all the current DDs and myself as WGM held a zoom meeting and discussed the situation. Any questions can be discussed with PGM Kris Schoville.

Now, I am not canceling the exchanges and you may ask why are you canceling the work and not the play? To attend the exchanges are completely voluntary and if you don't want to go, you don't rsvp. The DD schools need a quorum of at least 7 members of each chapter or else you do the school again alone. Most people are very devoted members and will be at the DD schools because the initiation counts toward 1 of the 2 needed by the code and they prefer to share the load of doing the school with most of our chapters not having a full corps of officers.

A special dispensation is included in the newsletter to hold at least 1 initiation for the term instead of the 2. We will also continue with not proving the chapter, but the AM should still know that all present are members.

The Grand Officers have helped 4 chapters with their initiation so far this year and will be helping 2 more. We are happy to help chapters bring in their new members!
