
Make sure your Secretary and Treasurer sends in by the 31st all your donations including your Pets for Vets coin jar money. We want to have very good totals for all



EASTERN STAR CEREMONY OF INSTALLATION

The following Ceremony of Installation provides acceptable guidelines for Grand Chapters and Subordinate Chapters during the **COVID Pandemic**. We recommend: the badges be cleaned/sanitized, no singing by the assembly, all wear a face mask, and maintain six feet of separation among members whenever possible. This has been approved by the Most Worthy Grand Matron and the General Grand Chapter Ritual Committee dated February 9, 2022.

NOTE: The General Grand Chapter Book of Instruction, Installation Ceremony, page 192, states "The Ritual gives no permission for more than one Installing Marshal..."

Therefore, a Sister or a Brother chosen by the WGM/WM and the WGP/WP (one each) will serve as a "Special Escort," to assist the Installing Marshal, if requested. The duties of the Special Escort will be to escort the WGM/WM and WGPWP to the altar for installation, invest the WGM/WM and WGP/WP with the badge of their office and conduct them to their stations in the East.

Installation Ceremony

The WGP/WP takes his station in the East and calls the Chapter to order with one blow of the gavel.

WGM/WM and Conductress take their stations and other outgoing Officers take designated seats in the Chapter Room.

Conductress opens the Bible.

Prayer offered by a member.

WGM/WM declares Chapter open for Ceremony of Installation

Pledge of Allegiance recited by a member.

Play National Anthem. (music only)

Welcome Distinguished Guests at their seats.

Remarks by WGM/WM and WGP/WP, if desired.

Introduction of Installing Officer and assistants (use appropriate title)

Installing Officer directs Installing Marshal to invite incoming Officers to enter. Installing Marshal does this from the Marshal's station.

The Officers to be installed enter the Chapter Room on the South and North marching lines, without wearing badges, and go straight to their respective stations.

PAGE TWO – Ceremony of Installation

- The incoming WGM/WM and incoming WGP/WP will take designated seats on the sidelines near the East.
- The Installing Chaplain and Installing Marshal take seats near the East.
- If the Alternate Investing of Badges (see below) is used, those who will invest the
 officer with their badge will take a seat next to/near the officer after the Installing
 Officers assume their stations.

Follow Ritual for Ceremony of Installation with following adaptations:

- When the Installing Officer calls up the chapter for the obligation, all members assume the reverent attitude.
- Officers being installed will remain at their stations. Officers being installed will give their assent to obligation.
- Installing Chaplain and Installing Marshal perform duties standing at their station
- The WGM/WM and WGP/WP are the only officers presented at the altar.

The Installing Marshal or Special Escort will present the WGM/WM and WGP/WP at the altar for installation, invest them with badge of office, and conduct them to the East.

- As each successive Officer is installed, the Officer will stand at his/her station and put on their badge at the direction of the Installing Officer.
- Alternate Investing of Badges
 - Prior to the installation, each officer to be installed will select a person to invest them with their badge of office. This will normally be a relative or close friend. This person will invest the installed officer with his/her badge of office when directed by the Installing Grand Officer.

Remarks by WGM/WM and WGP/WM.

Conductress closes the Bible.

Music (no singing)

Closing prayer (in lieu of Mizpah Benediction).

WGM/WM closes the Chapter with one blow of the gavel. (no retiring march)
