#### In Memoriam Shirley Patzwald, PGM

The Golden Chain of the Past Grands of Wisconsin has once again been broken with the passing of Past Grand Matron Sister Shirley Patzwald who passed away on July 20, 2022 at age 95.

Shirley was born on March 15, 1927, in West Allis Beloved daughter of the late Dwight W. Smith and the late Phoebe M. E. (nee Haase) Smith. Beloved wife of the late Robert G. Patzwald. Further preceded in death by each of her brothers and sisters, Dwight W. (Elaine) Smith, Elizabeth P. (Forest) Wilcox, Robert E. Smith, and Marlys D. (James) Crites. Also preceded in death by daughter-in-law Sandra (nee Feradi) Patzwald.

Survived by daughter Linda L. (Eugene) Hopkins and son Robert A. Patzwald. Dearest Grandmother of Robert L. (Christie) Hopkins, Johnathon (Andreanna) Patzwald, Jason (Jennifer Flenz) Patzwald, and Joanna (Zach) Clamors. Great-grandmother of Dylan Hopkins, DeAnna Hopkins, Henry Patzwald, Emersyn Patzwald, and Cohen Clamors. Further survived by many nieces, nephews, and longtime family friends.

Shirley was a member of First Church of Christ, Scientist in Wauwatosa, and Order of Eastern Star, Acadia Chapter No. 269, in Brookfield, where she was Past Matron. She served as Grand Worthy Matron of Wisconsin in 1985-1986. She was appointed Grand Esther by Sister Sonja Long and Brother Ed Falk in their "Wings of Joy" Grand Family.

Her session was known as the "Gateway to Unity", and the motto was "The Golden Chain of Strength". The symbols of the Square and Compasses and the Eastern Star were connected by a golden chain. In her installation address she stated that "These symbols only represent Masonry and Eastern Star Brothers and Sisters working in an effort of what blesses one, blesses all. In our work we learn that we may share with our Masonic Brothers in promulgating the principles of Brotherly Love, Relief and Truth. It is time that we begin to share the good we each have – the good of ideas – the good of action – the good of our people and resist all negativism."

Sister Shirley appointed Brothers as District Deputies for the first time. At her installation she welcomed them with "The appointment of Brothers who have earned their proficiency cards and their accepting this appointment serves as the first stop in our quest for unity by working within our own Order."

The sympathy of the Grand Chapter is lovingly extended to her family, to Wauwatosa Chapter and to her many friends. In token of sympathy and respect, let the charters of every Wisconsin subordinate chapter be draped for a period of 30 days and let this memorial be read at the next stated meeting of every Chapter.


