Statewide Chapter Activities (Dual Members will count for EACH Chapter):
Complete eight (8) of the twelve (12) Activities listed below

1. Three (3) or more members need to attend at least one (1) day of Grand Chapter. List the names of attending members and sessions attended.
2. Attend WGM/WGP party. List the date of the party and names attended.
3. Provide an item/basket, from your chapter, for the silent auction happening at any Grand Chapter event. ➤ Think out of the box to come up with new items. List the date of the party and name of item/basket donated.
4. Two (2) or more members need to attend All Member Learning Session/Exemplification. ➤ Try out a new Station. List date and members attended.
5. Attend a Grand Officer party. List the date of the party and names attended.
6. Attend a Grand Representative reception or celebration. List the date of the party and names attended.
7. Attend either Grand Chapter jurisdiction exchange. List the date of the exchange and names attended.
8. Three (3) or more members need to attend one (1), quarterly held, Area Club meeting. ➤ One of the members needs to be a first time Area Club attendee. List date of meeting and name of members attending, noting the first time attendee.
9. Visit a Masonic Youth Group. ➤ Meet and socialize with new people. List the name of the group, event and date attended.
10. Attend another Chapter's Grand Officer Visit, where the visiting officer is different from your chapter's visitor. ➤ Meeting and socializing with new people. List name of visitor, date and members attended.
11. Two (2) or more members need to attend another Chapter's stated meeting when they are having a special event/activity. ➤ Help out by being a Protém for them. List date of meeting, activity held and members attended.
12. Cheer to shut-in members from other chapters. List how you did this.

Home Chapter Activities (Dual members will count for EACH chapter):
Complete five (5) of the eight (8) activities listed below

1. Hold at least two (2) Honor Nights at a stated meeting. List Honor recognized and date of meeting.
2. Hold at least three (3) Special Event/Activities at a stated meeting, such as Halloween party, Bag Lunch night, Pajama party, Mix-up Station night, special speaker, ect. ➤Try something you haven't done at a chapter meeting before. List Activity and date of meeting.
3. Cheer to Shut-in members in your chapter, four (4) or more times throughout the year. List the times you reached out.
4. ➤Hold a Social event, non meeting related, to try something out of your comfort zone. Invite members, non-active members, prospects... Try a new restaurant, take a new road/route, try a new class, do something spontaneous, ect. List the date of the event and members in attendance.
5. At least one (1) social event attended by four (4) or more members, during recess months. List date, event and members attended.
6. Submit one (1) or more photos to the Starburst or Facebook page for publication. List activity photo was taken during and submit a copy of photo.
7. Complete three (3) or more fundraising activities throughout the year. Such as brat stands, dinners, designated charity marches, ect. List activities completed.
8. Provide two (2) or more Good of the Order programs, by different individuals, throughout the year. ➤ Share a topic that is new to your chapter, such as your favorite hobbies, talents, or interesting information. List date, member giving program and topic.

Membership Activities: (Dual members will count for EACH Chapter)

Complete three (3) of the five (5) activities listed below

1. Have a membership committee of at least three (3) people. List names of members.
2. Initiate a new member. List name(s) of member(s) and date of initiation.
3. Invite prospective and/or inactive members to social activities. List activity, date and member invited.
4. Do a random "pocket petition" check at two (2) or more stated meetings at your home chapter. If three (3) or more members have a 'pocket petition' with them, then the random check applies. List date of check and members with petitions on them.
5. ➤ Hand out three (3) or more pocket petitions throughout the year. List date handed out and member handing out.

Community and Charity Activities: (Dual member will count for EACH chapter)

Complete four (4) of the six (6) activities listed below

1. Make two (2) or more donations (monetary or goods) to at least two (2) different community organizations. Such as the local food pantry, school backpack program, Christmas Angel programs, ect. List organizations donated to.
2. Donate your time to at least two (2) community/charitable events. Such as Salvation Army bell ringing, Feed my starving children, blood drive, ect. List name and date of event.
3. Donations to OES Charities. List which charities were donated to.
4. Visit two (2) or more local community groups/events to promote Eastern Star.
➤ Provide a flyer or brochure to members of the group. Such as church groups, community parades, school programs ect. List name and date of event and members that attended.
5. Support local publications by submitting one (1) or more articles. Attach a copy of the article.
6. Support a local activity by a sponsorship. Examples: high school yearbook, community club, trunk or treat, community play, ect. List activity sponsored.
