WGM ACCOMPLISHMENT AWARD

April 1, 2024 – March 30, 2025

This is the 43rd year for the WGM Accomplishment Award. It can be achieved by earning a minimum number of points in each of four categories. Please keep the requirements in mind when you are planning your Chapter's activities for the year. This award is for those Chapters who go above and beyond the day to day events in their Chapters. Total points needed to earn the award are one-hundred eighty-five points.

Part A emphasizes attendance at Eastern Star events including visiting other chapters, supporting our Masonic Family groups and taking care of our shut-in Sisters and Brothers.

Part B encourages chapters to plan special evenings and events to engage chapter members.

Part C gives chapters credit for having a membership program to obtain and maintain active members.

Part D recognizes chapters for the good work done in their community and the support given to charities.

Assign one person from your chapter to keep track of the points. It can be very helpful to have an area included in your minutes to record activities. Review the requirements and points periodically to make sure you are on track to earn the award.

The award form must be:
