It is suggested that a WGM Accomplishment Award Committee be appointed that will keep track of the points. A Calendar could be kept at the Secretary's desk allowing members to chart visitations and other information.

Total points needed to earn the award are 230.

Part A emphasizes attendance at Eastern Star events, visiting other Chapters and Masonic Youth groups, and taking care of your shut-in Sisters and Brothers.

Part B encourages Chapters to plan special evenings and events within the Chapter to encourage members to participate.

Part C gives Chapters credit for a membership program.

Part D recognizes a Chapter for the good works they do in our communities and the support they give to a variety of charities
